# Call for 10<sup>o</sup> International Seminar for Local Public Economics

The Tenth Seminar of Local Public Economics emphasizes research that not only seeks to analyze the complexity of financing a greater production of services including tackling insecurity, but also that focuses on quality for transparency. Chetumal, being a border territory, is a space for analyzing the economy of these kinds of cities, but also taking into consideration the affluence of new technologies and the growth of smart cities.

The modality of the Seminar in its tenth edition will vary in regard to the previous ones. Following colleagues opinions on how to improve the events, it is now planned to have a more measured daily schedule, without leaving participants unable to appreciate the quality of the research presented, but also letting them appreciate the local context.

To this end, there will be conferences given by experts, and the presentations chosen will guarantee a space for learning and debate. The poster session will in turn encompass quality research and we will give more time and space for this. The organization of the sessions will allow for greater exchange and a more fluid discussion. At the same time, there will be space for cultural activities.
